Walk Summary:	<p>DUE TO CAMPSITE AVAILABILITY, NUMBERS ARE LIMITED TO TWELVE (12)</p> <p>a. For those who arrive Friday we will explore the local area on Saturday morning then after lunch, with the Saturday arrivals, take a short drive to the Elusive Lake carpark at 2:00pm. The walk commences at the small carpark on the West Wingan Road, 3km from the campground and meanders through eucalypt forest burnt in the 2020 fires. At the end of the walk, visitors arrive at a white, sandy beach and have the opportunity to explore along the shoreline. Up to 21 metres deep, Lake Elusive is the deepest dune blocked coastal lake in Victoria.</p> <p>b. This walk is along part of the Wilderness Coast Walking Track. From the camping ground we walk along the edge of the Inlet and along the beach to the start of the Petrel Point walking track. We follow this to the Petrel Point Beach, diverting briefly along the way to climb to a trig point on Rame Head which has magnificent views of the coastline and ocean. We will have lunch on the Petrel Point beach before walking back to the camping ground.</p>
