Walk Summary:	<p>From the picnic area at Log Crossing we will walk upstream along on a well made track at the side of Mississippi Creek amongst huge white Stringybark and Silvertop Ash trees and lush undergrowth of ferns and other greenery. We cross over the Creek several times with views into the creek, you might be lucky enough to see the odd fish or other critters. After about 7kms we reach the site of the old granite quarry. Some of the granite from this site has been transported to Melbourne and made into benchtops in some of the old historical buildings in the city.
