Walk Summary:	<p>Morwell NP is a small, unique area of remnant forest in the northern foothills of the Strezlecki Ranges. It includes fern gullies, dryer eucalypt ridges, revegetated river flats, nature gum and 43 species of native orchids, some of which are declared rare. Wildlife in the park are wallabies, wombats, possums, kangaroos and koalas.</p> <p>We will join Friends of Morwell National Park for their annual Orchid walk at 10am.</p> <p>We will be back at the picnic area for lunch. After lunch we can go onto Billy's Creek Trail towards the old weir.</p>
