Walk Summary:	<p>*Uralla Nature Reserve at the south edge of Trafalgar, is a 40min drive from Traralgon; this walk includes a moderately challenging uphill section, labelled 'brutal' on some sites, with a steep downhill section also (loose gravel underfoot), and trekking poles are recommended. Mountain Grey Gums, endangered and threatened plants, and many types of bird life can be found in this 60hectare natural bush land.</p> <p>*A short drive to a lookout over the township of Trafalgar and beyond, then on to Thorpdale for toilet facilities, undercover picnic areas, and the Thorpdale Bakery – buy lunch, or BYO.</p> <p>*Then a short drive to the Lyrebird Forest Walk near Mirboo North for the Warrior Walk, with a moderate uphill section. The Little Morwell River, eucalypts, tree ferns and coral ferns, and many types of birds, including the elusive lyrebird make this an enjoyable walk. A thirty minute return drive to Traralgon.</p>
