Walk Summary:	<p>*Uralla Nature Reserve at the south edge of Trafalgar, 40min drive from Traralgon; a moderately challenging uphill section, labelled 'brutal' on some sites, with a steep downhill section also (loose gravel underfoot), trekking poles recommended, 3.5km.</p> <p>*A short drive to a lookout over the township of Trafalgar and beyond, then on to Thorpdale for facilities, undercover picnic areas, and the Thorpdale Bakery – buy lunch, or BYO.</p> <p>*Then a short drive to the Lyrebird Forest Walk near Mirboo North for the Warrior Walk, with a moderate uphill section, 4.3km. A thirty minute return drive to Traralgon.</p>
