Walk Summary:	<p>The aim of the trip is to provide the opportunity for members who would not normally undertake multi day hikes to experience sections of the AAWT and other walks in an area seldom visited by our club..</p> <p>Note. the Camp Creek campsite is accessible via Speculation Road which is four wheel drive only. Final numbers will be dependant on adequate four wheel drive transport.</p> <p>Day 1, After meeting at Howitt Park Bairnsdale, we will drive to Myrtleford via Mount Hotham then onto Cheshunt via Lake Buffalo. From there we will take a short drive to Paradise Falls (geological wonder) before heading for our campsite at Bennies beside the Rose River.</p> <p>Day 2, After packing up we then drive to Lake Cobbler stopping on the way to view the Dandongadale Falls. From the shores of Lake Cobbler 1106 metres above sea level we take the walking track which leads to the summit of Mount Cobbler. Note the final approach to the top of Mount Cobbler requires the use of hands and feet scrambling over rocks. After returning to our vehicles we will drive to Camp Creek campsite just below the summit of Mount Speculation.</p> <p>Day 3, Walk south along the AAWT over Mount Speculation to Mount Buggery and possibly beyond before returning to camp. This walk requires the use of hands and feet in several sections.</p> <p>Day 4, Walk north along the AAWT past Catherine Saddle to Mount Despair, returning along the closed section of Speculation Road.</p> <p>Day 5, Pack up and depart for home.</p>
