Walk Summary:	<p>This walk will require a longish drive west from Sale to get to the start point. We turn off the highway at Darnum and after a pleasant drive through farmland we reach the picnic area at Mount Worth State Park. From the start point at the picnic area we will initially pass the site of the historic Maslin's Mill before following the Moonlight Creek Track which meanders through an area peppered with tree ferns and tall mountain ash trees. At the western end of the Park, we will encounter a challenging climb before gradually descending and picking up the Waterfall Bower track which has great photo opportunities. The Parks Victoria Visitor Guide describes this as "a strenuous walk suitable for experienced walkers". The rewards are a very scenic environment including waterfalls, tree ferns and mountain ash.</p> <p>NB The track can be very muddy and slippery, particularly after rain, so hiking poles are strongly recommended.</p> <p>Registration with the Walk Leader, before the day of the walk, is required for all walks. Preference is to register via email please.</p>
